Background

The PearScape Trail project was established in 2016 by the Visit Pearland team to promote cultural tourism and community pride by returning pears to Pearland in an entirely different and artistic format, scattered sculptures of the namesake fruit.

The trail began with 20 four-foot pear sculptures, painted by local artists and placed at visitor destinations across Pearland, and continues to grow with more sculptures sponsored and planted.

An initial committee developed the criteria, defined the pear design mold, and Visit Pearland funded the initial cost of the 20 pears from the city's hotel/motel occupancy tax. Remaining funds for the PearScape Trail were raised through pear sponsorship tiers, which consisted of gold, green, and community levels. The program continues to be managed by Visit Pearland, and we're incredibly grateful for the hard work and dedication of our many PearScape partners.

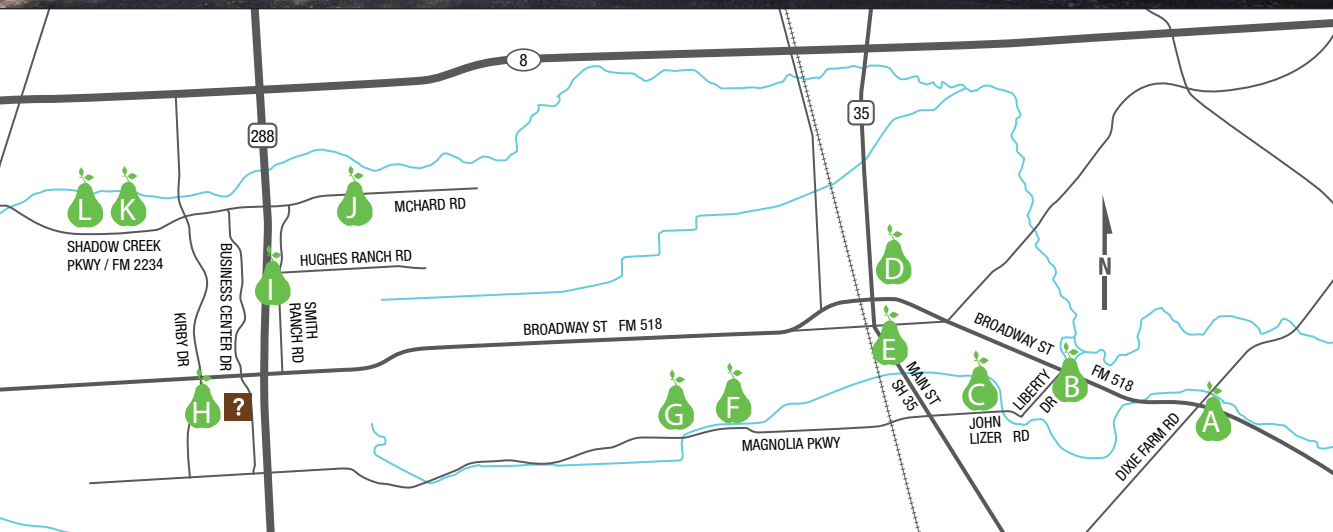
